**Reflections on the Fifth
Sunday in Ordinary Time:**

All of the earth is full of the glory of God. Each of us is invited to this understanding of the great gift of life. We all need the help and the power of God. Jesus is there when we need Him. How do we recognize the ways of God in the everyday activities of life? The three readings today deal with people called by God for a specific task or mission through the grace of God. Jesus invites all of us in the circumstances of our lives to bring His Word to others. There is a holiness in any call from God. The readings today are calling us to expand our understanding of the ways that God may be calling us to work for His Kingdom. Sinfulness is no excuse for refusing the call of the Lord as He works with us as we are and He creates the opportunities. Responding to the will of God requires willingness and trust in God. Openness in prayer is essential as God speaks to us in many ways, including ways that at first we may not understand, but we need to take risks and trust the Lord. Such risks include extending love, offering forgiveness, and offering hope.
