**Reflections on the Eighth
Sunday in Ordinary Time:**

We have all been given certain expressions and words to live our lives with. These life-lesson words are not limited by one's faith but are universal. In today's Gospel, there are a number of sayings for all to seriously consider. Jesus expressed so eloquently so much wisdom which goes to the heart of living life.

One such saying is to take the plank out of our own eyes before we remove the speck in somebody else's eyes. A person who cannot see cannot guide another person. This thought needs to be considered in many ways. This thought is also a nice thought to pay serious attention to as the Season of Lent begins on Wednesday March 6th. We are told not to overlook our own faults when we see the faults of others. Sometimes people do not see the planks in their own eyes or their own faults, and, if they did, they would see the situations of life much differently. Our faults and growing spots include what we do and what we do not do. Sometimes our own faults can be such that we might not make the right choices or give the right advice. Sometimes we might not see the true goodness or the potential for goodness in another person. Do we see and consider all the ways that God blesses us. Do we give thanks to God for all of this? One of the powerful messages that Jesus sends is to give people the benefit of the doubt.

God looks at how we relate to others. Jesus is the answer to overcome sin and death. Lent is a time to see and discover the planks in our eyes, the blessings of God in our hearts, and to focus on Jesus.
