Reflections on the Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Upon first reading or hearing this gospel today, one might get the wrong impression or be afraid of what Jesus is asking of us. Do we view situations in our lives as obstacles or as opportunities for spiritual growth? Each of us is free to do the loving thing or to be consumed by selfishness. Through our baptism, each of us is invited to follow Jesus and His message more closely each day. The readings today should not be taken literally, but the message to follow Jesus requires a radical commitment. Jesus tells us not to be trapped by anxiety or the past. Now is the right moment to follow Jesus with hope and enthusiasm. There are times in our lives when we feel so overwhelmed that it is hard to keep things in perspective.
