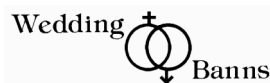

**Memorial Day**

It is almost impossible to thank everyone who worked to make Memorial Day special for our parish. On the Thursday before Memorial Day, students from the Randolph Middle School and the Randolph High School and their teachers traveled to St. Mary Cemetery early in the morning. They were joined by the Sailors of the USS Constitution and many town officials. Their purpose in coming was to decorate all the graves of veterans in our cemetery by placing a geranium and flag at their resting place. Before proceeding, the students were treated to a wonderful presentation by staff members of the USS Constitution. Once finished, a pizza lunch was served in our school hall. Again it is impossible to thank all the students and teachers, the town officials, the sailors, and the cemetery crew, but please know that the honor you paid to all those who served in the military to protect our freedom did not go unnoticed.

On Memorial Day the parade also stops in St. Mary Cemetery in our veteran's section. A brief service is held here by members of the Randolph Veteran's Council with music performed by the Randolph High School band. Our collaborative Pastor, Fr. Phil McGaugh, gave a beautiful invocation and benediction. As always St. Mary cemetery looked beautiful as a result of the hard worked done by the cemetery staff.

Once the parade reformed on North Street, it was time to get to work for our Memorial Day Mass on the grounds of the cemetery. Over three hundred chairs were set up early in the morning on the grass near the Pastoral Center. After the parade, the altar, and podium were set out.
