### Reflections on the Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's Gospel, in the story of the Good Samaritan, we see the true meaning of love of neighbor. Notice that Jesus gives us a very specific formula for loving God and neighbor. All human beings need our help and our prayers. Without the grace and help of God, we could not be as good and focused on helping ourselves and others. We often notice how love responds with grace to the unexpected. Jesus heals, and he also invites us to be part of this. Before we seek to be healed or to help someone else experience the healing love of Jesus, we might consider looking at the appropriate passages from Sacred Scripture as well to bring us hope and comfort. To love means to serve. This week what will we do to show love of God and love of neighbor? This week may we pray for the universal Church and also pray for world peace.
