Reflections on the Twenty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time

The readings are telling us that we must give top priority to Jesus and His Heavenly Father. As we enter a time of discipleship in ministry, it is important to ask some questions. How are things different? How do we each day, throughout the day, let people know what Jesus means to us? How do we show people what our faith means to us? Discipleship is more than just denouncing possessions as it is all about witnessing our faith and finding true happiness in Jesus. It is to do the will of God. Our life and our prayer needs to be connected to liturgy. Liturgy and prayer makes ultimate sense in terms of mutual concern for others modeled after the teachings of Jesus. What do we hope to do in the future to work for Jesus and build up His Kingdom? There is always room to grow in the way of the Lord.

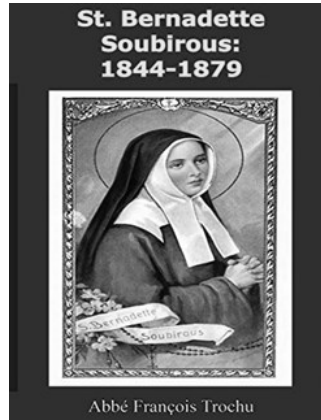


Classes for grades 1-8 will begin next Sunday, September 15th, for both English and Vietnamese-speaking children.
